

Starlink and Ubiquiti Wireless for a Remote Cattle Station

A remote cattle station lost all internet access when the local 3G network was shut down. The homestead, yards and outbuildings needed reliable connectivity for operations, safety and family communication. We installed Starlink as the primary link and four Ubiquiti outdoor access points to blanket the homestead and yard area with fast, stable Wi-Fi.

BEFORE

- 3G shutdown left the station with no usable internet at all
- Homestead, cattle yards, machinery shed and staff quarters all needed coverage
- Existing mobile coverage was patchy and insufficient for cloud apps and video calls
- Long distances and harsh outback conditions made a standard fixed-line service impossible

AFTER

- 4 - Ubiquiti access points covering homestead and yards
- 100+ - Mbps download speeds via Starlink
- 24/7 - connectivity for operations and safety systems
- Installed Starlink as the primary high-speed satellite internet connection

"After the 3G shutdown we were completely cut off. Now the whole station has fast internet - the homestead, the yards, the machinery shed. The kids can do schoolwork, the office can run cloud apps, and we can monitor weather and water systems without driving around."
