

Migrated 1000 Users from On-Premise Exchange 2019 to Office 365

A large organisation was running Exchange 2019 on ageing on-premise hardware, struggling with remote access, mobile email, and the looming cost of a server refresh. We moved 1000 mailboxes to Office 365, unlocking Email, Teams, and OneDrive across the workforce.

KEY RESULTS

BEFORE

- 1000 mailboxes tied to ageing Exchange 2019 servers facing a hardware refresh cycle
- Remote and mobile staff had a poor email experience without modern apps or MFA
- No central collaboration platform - file sharing relied on email attachments and network drives
- On-premise infrastructure created a single point of failure for business communication

AFTER

- 1000 - users migrated to Office 365
- 0 - on-premise Exchange servers remaining
- 24/7 - email, Teams and OneDrive access from any device
- Assessed the existing Exchange environment, mailbox sizes, and dependency on legacy add-ins
